



## DCBC Student Summer Camp Rules for 2008

**DCBC Student Summer Camp is a Christian camp.  
All rules are to help us reflect Christ in all that we say and do.**

- Please respect all camp properties just as you would at the church you attend. We ask you to assist in keeping the grounds clean. Trash cans are provided camp-wide to contain debris.
- Items not permitted at camp:  
*illegal drugs, alcohol, knives, ANY form of tobacco, guns, pets, skateboards or fireworks.*  
*These items will be confiscated.*
- Unless used specifically for the camp program, the following are not permitted at camp:  
*radios, CD/MP3/I-pods/tape players, cell phones, and other non-essential electronic devices.*
- If property or equipment is damaged, your group will be held responsible for repair/replacement costs.
- If dorm room is excessively filthy upon departure, your church will be charged a \$50 cleaning fee.
- **NO SWIMMING.** The lake is for fishing and not approved by the Health Department for swimming.
- Shorts are permitted, but must be at least fingertip length.
- Shoes must be worn at all times (unless camper is in the pool or on volleyball courts).
- No hats are to be worn during worship.
- No clothing which is revealing or suggestive. *NO spaghetti strap garments.* Modesty is the best policy.
- Swimsuits must be MODEST. Guys: NO Speedo-types Girls: NO thongs/bikini-style. (midriff covered)  
Lifeguards can eject anyone not properly clothed in the pool area.
- NO shaving cream/water fights, etc.
- NO use of the Ropes Course unless camp authorized with trained personnel present.
- Meals will be in the Dining Hall unless otherwise arranged with the camp.
- Students are NOT allowed to leave the camp grounds.
- Students MUST attend all scheduled sessions and activities.
- Students are NOT allowed to ride in/on any vehicle.
- Students are NOT allowed to enter dorms of the opposite sex for ANY reason.
- NO PUBLIC/ PRIVATE DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION will be tolerated.
- Students are NOT allowed to share ANY medications. All medications (prescription/non-prescriptions) must be checked into the First Aide Station upon arrival.
